## Sunday, January 24, 2021

Welcome to Salem's Drive-In Worship! We will gather in our main parking lot each Sunday morning at 10:30 (weather permitting). As we gather for Worship, here are the procedures and guidelines for Worship:

- 1). Please tune your radio to FM station 87.9. Music will begin at 10:00 am. Please tune-in to get your settings ready prior to the beginning of Worship. You may need to increase the volume of your radio quite a bit. <u>This is normal for the radio transmitter</u>.
- **2**). Everyone will receive a bag containing everything you need for worship. The ushers will also collect your offerings.
- **3). Don't forget to turn down your radio's volume after the Service!** Due to the settings of the transmitter, most radios need to be higher than normal volume for the Service!

# WELCOME AND ANNOUNCEMENTS

### **CONFESSION AND FORGIVENESS**

## FIRST READING: Jonah 3: 1-5, 10

The First Reading is from the 3rd chapter of Jonah.

<sup>1</sup>The word of the Lord came to Jonah a second time, saying, <sup>2</sup>"Get up, go to Nineveh, that great city, and proclaim to it the message that I tell you." <sup>3</sup>So Jonah set out and went to Nineveh, according to the word of the Lord. Now Nineveh was an exceedingly large city, a three days' walk across. <sup>4</sup>Jonah began to go into the city, going a day's walk. And he cried out, "Forty days more, and Nineveh shall be overthrown!" <sup>5</sup>And the people of Nineveh believed God; they proclaimed a fast, and everyone, great and small, put on sackcloth.

<sup>10</sup>When God saw what they did, how they turned from their evil ways, God changed his mind about the calamity that he had said he would bring upon them; and he did not do it.

#### **PSALM: Psalm 62: 5-12** (Read responsively)

<sup>5</sup>For God alone I wait in silence; truly, my hope is in God.

<sup>6</sup>God alone is my rock and my salvation, my stronghold, so that I shall never be shaken.

<sup>7</sup>In God is my deliverance and my honor; God is my strong rock and my refuge.

<sup>8</sup>Put your trust in God always, O people, pour out your hearts before the one who is our refuge.

<sup>9</sup>Those of high degree are but a fleeting breath; those of low estate cannot be trusted. Placed on the scales together they weigh even less than a breath.

# <sup>10</sup>Put no trust in extortion; in robbery take no empty pride; though wealth increase, set not your heart upon it.

<sup>11</sup>God has spoken once, twice have I heard it, that power belongs to God.

<sup>12</sup>Steadfast love belongs to you, O Lord, for you repay all according to their deeds.

### SECOND READING: 1 Corinthians 7: 29-31

The Second Reading is from the 7<sup>th</sup> chapter of 1 Corinthians.

<sup>29</sup>Brothers and sisters, the appointed time has grown short; from now on, let even those who have wives be as though they had none, <sup>30</sup>and those who mourn as though they were not mourning, and those who rejoice as though they were not rejoicing, and those who buy as though they had no possessions, <sup>31</sup>and those who deal with the world as though they had no dealings with it. For the present form of this world is passing away.

#### GOSPEL: Mark 1: 14-20

The Gospel according to St. Mark .

<sup>14</sup>Now after John was arrested, Jesus came to Galilee, proclaiming the good news of God, <sup>15</sup>and saying, "The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God has come near; repent, and believe in the good news." <sup>16</sup>As Jesus passed along the Sea of Galilee, he saw Simon and his brother Andrew casting a net into the sea—for they were fishermen. <sup>17</sup>And Jesus said to them, "Follow me and I will make you fish for people." <sup>18</sup>And immediately they left their nets and followed him. <sup>19</sup>As he went a little farther, he saw James son of Zebedee

and his brother John, who were in their boat mending the nets. <sup>20</sup>Immediately he called them; and they left their father Zebedee in the boat with the hired men, and followed him.
