Dear Salem Family,

So much has changed since the last time we have gathered together in person for worship. Sometimes it seems like things are changing so quickly that it's hard to keep up. It is in times like this that I am reminded of the Psalms. "God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble. Therefore we will not fear, though the earth should change, though the mountain shake in the heart of the sea; though its waters roar and foam, through the mountains tremble with its tumult." (Psalm 46:1-3) I am reminded that no matter what, God is always faithful and always present with us.

This Sunday begins the week that is the center of the story we proclaim as God's people: Holy week. We begin this weekend with Palm Sunday, as we celebrate with the disciples as Jesus enters Jerusalem. Things will look different this year. And yet in that difference, we find touchpoints of tradition and are reminded that the story remains the same. We might even identify more with the disciples this year – they too were uncertain about the future.
